

Competition

The Borjan Tanevski Scholar for study at ACT will be named again this academic year. The scholarship carries an award of 1500 euros from the Borjan Tanevski Memorial Fund and 800 euros, kindly donated by Mr Gert Peshkatari. The Borjan Tanevski Scholar will be honored at the 2007 Commencement ceremony. The 2007 scholar and authors of selected essays will be invited to present at an international student conference in Skopje.

According to the statute of the Borjan Tanevski Memorial Fund, the winner of the scholarship is decided on the basis of an anonymous essay competition:

Essay:

2500 words maximum on a subject set and announced by the jury within the area of "Peace and Cooperation in South-East Europe". In 2006/2007, the subject is:

"Foreign direct investment: Curse or Blessing?"

Candidates:

Open to all current regular undergraduate ACT students (and accepted applicants) who have an overall GPA of at least 3.0 (or no GPA yet).

Jury

The winner is decided by a jury of five academics (Profs. Kourkoumelis, Mueller, Wisner from ACT, Prof. Maleska, Skopje/Tetovo and Prof. Zaikos, Ioannina), following anonymous reviewing and an interview with the three best candidates.

03.03.2007 Interview with 3 best candidates, final decision
